SPAIN - ROAD RESTRICTIONS FOR TRUCKS WITH DG & ORANGE PLATE

Every year the Traffic Department Spain, published the network itineraries for dangerous goods by road, imposing special safety measures for traffic control, during the year 2015.

For the next years (2016, 2017, etc...) we have a new road restrictions, but for weekend (point 2) always is the same regulations and can change for bank holidays (point 3) and local holidays.

Main points for understanding, these road restrictions:

Chapter B.2 Dangerous goods. Trucks with Orange plate ADR

- 1.- All trucks with DG & Orange plate, must go by road in this order:
- 1.1 Highways, if there are not Highways, so must choose Motorways
- 1.2 Motorways, if there are not Motorways, so must chose National roads
- 1.3 National roads
- 2.- Weekend, Dark box, means Road restrictions for DG




